

2016 - 2017

Choreography Creation of the Catastroflux collective with the composer and musician Floriane Dardard. 2-week residency at Tanztendenz Munich with the collective culminating in the presentation of a 20min dance and music duet titled 'Absurd Journey'. 1 month residency at PlayPractice, Bangalore, India with a presentation of a 40min version of the duet at Shoonya cultural centre and an adaptation of the project in collaboration with local artists. Research residency at Tanztendenz Munich from March to August 2017 to create movement games and material based on neuroscientific research. Creation of two short pieces: 'Slow' for 9 dancers presented in November 2016 and 'Qube' for 2 dancers and a wooden cube to be presented at the Hier=Jetzt festival in March 2017.

Workshops and performance: Performances in Bangalore with a group of experimental contemporary dancers and musicians. Performance for Mehdi Farajpour in Paris as part of the final presentation of the Paris Summer Academy. 3 week intensive movement research and choreography with the SNDO program at the AHK, Amsterdam. Research and performance project with Mia Lawrence in Munich involving yoga, meditation, self-enquiry and improvisation. Improvised performances at the Muffathalle studios and Gasteig in the Dance festival. Training in kuchipudi and kalaripayattu in Bangalore, India.
